Youth Competitions

Competition	Coaching Requirement
U15, U17 Tier 1	C License Trained <u>OR</u> Higher
U13 Tier 1	Soccer For Life Trained
U15+, Tiers 2-4	Soccer For Life Trained
U13, Tiers 2-4	Learn to Train Trained <u>OR</u> Soccer For Life Trained

- Removing the exemptions as courses are now available on line
- Making Ethical Decisions (MED) is now part of the coaching courses

Youth Competition Proposed Rule Change

- The home district can allow the district where they are playing to use their declaration
- Rational:
A team is playing and within another district they can choose to keep their own declaration or allow the other district to use it. This allows for a more accurate ranking at provincials.
