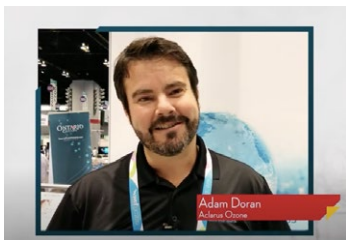


## NETWORK

## FUNDING

Prepare for international markets and access new opportunities with **CanExport** funding.

**CanExport SMEs:** Canadian small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) wanting to export their products and services to new international markets can apply for funding up to \$50,000. Eligible activities include:

- › online advertising including search engine optimization
- › participation in virtual trade events and fairs
- › legal advice, certification and IP protection

**CanExport Innovation:** Canadian SMEs, academic institutions and non-government research centers can apply to cover as much as 75% of costs associated with the development of R&D collaborations and commercialization of new technologies through partnerships in international markets.

## SUPPORT

Tap into support to gain knowledge, get tailored advice and benefit from guidance to help your business enter markets outside Canada.

**Canadian Technology Accelerators (CTAs):** High-potential start-up and scale-up companies with an existing technology, product or service can explore business growth opportunities in North America, Asia and Europe through virtual accelerators. CTAs focus on 3 main sectors of activity:

- › cleantech
- › life sciences
- › information and communications technologies (ICT)

**Inclusive trade support:** The TCS is dedicated to ensuring Canada's exporters are representative of the country's diversity by offering dedicated support for export-ready businesses owned by women, Indigenous peoples, LGBTQ2+, visible minorities and youth.
