TRANSITIONAL VOCATION PROGRAM

We offer learning opportunities for adults with developmental disabilities at Mount Royal University.

TVP helps you learn new skills to successfully enter the workforce. You can get help with your reading, math, computer skills, and learn to take care of your health and financial well-being. We can also help you prepare to write the Alberta Learner's licence test.

EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT

Employment Preparation Certificate

This is a full-time 12-month program to help you get a job and have a more independent lifestyle. Learn job skills in the classroom and work with your own Employment Specialist to get a job placement. Your performance will be evaluated regularly. Develop a positive attitude and social skills. Learn to be organized. Application is required. The application form is available at mru.ca/TVP or from the TVP office.

Is this program for you?

The Employment Preparation Certificate is ideal if you:

- are 18 years of age or older with a developmental disability
- have previously taken a vocational or special education program
- are capable of using public transit independently
- have a level of independence that precludes constant support

EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE

This one year of extra support is open only to previous Employment Preparation Certificate graduates. Support includes continued job placement and assistance with job retention. The registration form is available at mru.ca/TVP or from the TVP office.

PART-TIME COURSES

These part-time classes help you work on the Essential Skills. Daytime or evening classes in the fall, winter and spring semesters. Small class sizes.
