BIG IDEA: God is so, so powerful.

BIBLE BASIS: Exodus 7:12–10:20

KEY VERSE: “Great is our Lord. His power is mighty.” Psalm 147:5

★ SINGING & STORY TIME

★ APPLICATION ACTIVITIES

GOD HELPS ME PYRAMID (Craft Activity)

Cut out and color the frogs on the “God Helps Me Pyramid.” Put glue along the edge to make a pyramid. As you work together on the “God Helps Me” pyramid, use these questions as conversation starters.

Question: Why do you think Pharaoh refused to let God’s people go?

Question: If you could have seen one of the times that God showed His power to Pharaoh, which one would you want to see? (Ex. water to blood, frogs, flies, hail, darkness.) Why?

FLY TRAP (Application Activity)

Place raisins in a bowl. Give each person one raisin to start with. Tell the children to pretend like their raisin is a fly. Have everyone look up at the ceiling and balance the fly on their face at the top of their cheek. Challenge them to move and scrunch their face in an attempt to wriggle the fly into their mouth. They may not use their hands. If the fly falls on the floor, throw it away and have them take a new raisin from the bowl. Before they can take a new raisin, though, they must say, “**God is so, so powerful.**”

In our true Bible story for today, God used his power to fill the sky with lots and lots of flies. The people didn’t just have one fly on their face, they had flies covering everything. Only God can do that. That’s because **God is so, so powerful.**

Question: Can you think of anything else that only God can do?

POWERFUL PRAYERS

Tell everyone to think of a way that God shows his power (e.g. – rainstorms, rugged mountains, making people well, etc.) After brainstorming...do popcorn prayers by having each person start with “God shows us his power by _____” and fill in the blank with your ideas. Close by declaring “**God is so, so powerful**” together.
